Hospitality rider – Theaters

Ventriloquism places severe strain on the voice. The following requirements are designed to protect David's voice and leave him in the best condition to entertain your audience.

Water – A minimum of two (2) 16 oz. bottles of drinking water are to be provided for each performance. Water should be left at room temperature, not chilled. We're not too picky about brand, with one exception; Dasani brand water is NOT acceptable. We've found it has some type of minerals that affect David's voice. Pretty much anything else is fine, including store brands.

Dressing room – A clean, safe, quiet and secure location that is environmentally controlled for temperature and humidity to rest and do vocal warm-ups before and between performances is to be provided. A restroom should be nearby. This space should be relatively close to the performance area. Access to this space is to be tightly controlled, allowing only authorized personnel.

Hotel – (If being provided per the contract) One, double occupancy, NON-SMOKING room, at a 3-star level or above hotel. Good examples: Hampton Inn, Holiday Inn Express, Hyatt Place.

Meals – In most cases, David will take care of his own food. If you would like to provide snacks, or if a meal is specified in the contract, he prefers fruits (gala apples and/or bananas) and a simple sandwich (wheat bread with crunchy peanut butter, or cold cuts & cheese).

General safety and security – Purchaser/client/facility agrees to be solely responsible for the safety and security of any props and other equipment stored at the venue, both while on stage and in storage between performances.
